

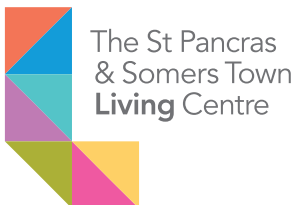
Somers Town Community Newsletter



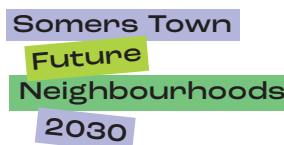

Somers Town Community Association, has served, supported, worked and been part of the community of Somers Town since 1985 and during that time we have and will continue to listen to the views of the community and what they feel we are and are not doing, could be doing, should be doing and what we could be doing better.

To this end we have listened to your concerns about local spaces and how you feel that they are not perhaps being used in the best way that they could be for the community of Somers Town, and that they are not always as accessible in terms of residents accessing space as they should/could be.

To this end we are working with all of our local partners to open STCA as a **Youth & Community Hub**, giving our Youth team a home whilst also allowing us to reframe local support for young people and their families, that will look at strengthening relationships, supporting networks and community cohesion.

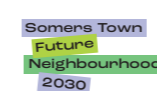
Stay Warm
